- (1) For those having successfully completed a Master' s degree or expected to earn one before the semester starts
- (2) For those equivalent to the above approved by the related academic policy

※ Students are allowed to apply different majors from their undergraduate or MA studies.

### ■ Transfer Admission

1. 2<sup>nd</sup> semester : Those who (will) have completed more than 1 semester and earned more than 6 major credits of MA/Ph.D courses from other university.
2. 3<sup>rd</sup> semester : Those who (will) have completed more than 2 semester and earned more than 12 major credits of MA/Ph.D courses from other university.

- It is your responsibility to ensure that all the information on your application form is correct. Changes cannot be made after submission of your application.
- Application number will be given after the completion of payment.
- Prospective graduates among admitted students must submit the “official certificate of graduation” and “official academic transcript” to the graduate school office before the course begins.
- After the application on the website, applicants should submit required documents within the deadline(2022. 01. 06. 12:00) in person or by post.
- If you have not submitted all the required documents, your application will be excluded from the evaluation.
- No-attendance for oral interview will disqualify you with any reason.  
【Applicants for Fine Arts Department must submit portfolios】
- Please bring the identification card on the interview day.
- Transfer applicants must contact the Graduate School Office after the completion of online application.
- The application process will follow the rules established by the Graduate School Admissions Committee.
- If a document is written in other languages than English and Korean, it should be submitted along with notarized copies translated into English or Korean.
